- Mapping legal principles with operational and technical requirements
- The only int'l document on regulation of EV from controlled and uncontrolled environments
- Referenced by countries and organizations inside and outside the CoE region

II. LESSONS LEARNED (1)

- Correct original flaws of wording and structure
- Distinguish EV in Supervised vs. Unsupervised environments
- Consider evolution of national EV legislations

- Limits of reasoning by “analogy” with traditional channels
